Day 1 – January 9 - Wednesday: USA – Tel Aviv

Overnight flight to Tel Aviv.

Day 2 – January 10 - Thursday: Tel Aviv – Netanya

Flight for the London Party to Tel Aviv. Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport near Tel Aviv. You will be met and assisted with a Coral Travel & Tours representative inside the terminal. Meet your guide and driver and drive to your hotel in Netanya. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Netanya.

Day 3 – January 11 - Friday: Caesarea – Megiddo – Sea of Galilee

After your Israeli breakfast, travel to **Caesarea**, the seat of the Roman Procurator of Judea at the time of the Christ, and the site where Peter converted the centurion Cornelius. This fortified harbor city was built 2000 years ago by King Herod the Great. View the ruins of Roman, Byzantine and Crusader times. Explore the Roman Theater and the Aqueducts. A drive up **Mt. Carmel** will bring us to the site where Elijah challenged and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal. Continue to **Megiddo**, the Fortress City of King Solomon, later built again by King Ahab. The books of Daniel and Revelation will come alive as we study about the final Battle of Armageddon, while viewing the Plains of Jezreel. Drive to your hotel near the Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight: Hotel near the Sea of Galilee.

Day 4 – January 12 - Saturday: The Galilee Sea Coast

Spend the day at the Galilee Sea Coast calling the Disciples. Visit **Peter Primacy**. Continue to the **Mt. of Beatitudes**, site of the Sermon on the Mount. Visit **Tabgha** where the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fish took place. See the ruins of **Capernaum**, the town where Jesus made his home after leaving Nazareth. Visit **Kursi**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel near the Sea of Galilee.

Day 5 – January 13 – Sunday: Kfar Kedem – Nazareth Village - Yardenit

This morning you will visit **Kfar Kedem** that welcomes you to experience the taste of the Galilee with their authentic, mouth-watering menus. Take part in a **"Donkey Trail"** - and the LORD opened the mouth of the ass. And the ass said unto Balaam: 'Am not I thine ass, upon which thou hast ridden all thy lifelong unto this day? Was I ever wont to do so unto thee?' And he said: 'Nay.'" (Numbers 22:28-30.) Enjoy a **Hafla** which is a traditional meal served to guests from 2000 years ago until today. Abraham rode the original 4x4! Mount your donkey to ride through the Galilee hills - get to lead a donkey! It is such a lot of FUN! Step into the Bible at **Nazareth Village** and experience life in the first century. Knowledgeable and gifted guides will take you through the Nazareth Jesus knew. Hear Jesus' words, especially the parables, and learn about his world, while seeing the stories come to life. End the day at **Yardenit**, the Baptismal Center site on the Jordan River where you will have an opportunity to be baptized (optional). Dinner and overnight: Hotel near the Sea of Galilee.

Day 6 – January 14 – Monday: Galilee Sea

After breakfast visit the **"Ancient Boat"** at kibbutz Ginossar believed to be from Jesus' time. Take a **boat ride** (for 3 hours) on the Sea of Galilee where you will have time for worship. For lunch you will be able to sample the **St. Peter fish** at **Kibbutz Ein Gev**. In the afternoon visit **Kursi (Gaderenes)**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel near the Sea of Galilee.

Day 7 – January 15 - Tuesday: Tel Dan – Caesarea Philippe

This morning drive along the Hula Valley to **Tel Dan** and visit the remains of the city. Continue to the Banias, site of the ancient **Caesarea Philippe**. It is here that Peter made his confession of faith in Jesus (Matthew 16:13). Ride through the **Golan Heights** and stop at **Mt. Bental**. Return to the Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight: Hotel near the Sea of Galilee.

Day 8 – January 16 - Wednesday: Bet She'an – Ein Gedi - Dead Sea

In the morning leave the Sea of Galilee and drive to **Bet She'an** where recent excavations have unveiled the impressive ruins of the country's largest city in the Roman and Byzantine periods, which was destroyed by an earthquake in 749 AD. The tour continues through the **Jordan Valley** past Jericho, believed to be the world's oldest walled city. This was the first city taken by Joshua when the Hebrews returned from Egypt – 'and the walls fell down.' It was also the site of the Mount of Temptation (Mark 1:13). Drive along the shores of the Dead Sea to **Ein Gedi**, an oasis on the Dead Sea shore and the site where David hid from King Saul (First Samuel 24: 1-23). A walk around the park confirms that Ein Gedi is one of the most beautiful reservations in the world. In the afternoon enjoy a float on the unsinkable **Dead Sea**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel at the Dead Sea.

Day 9 – January 17 – Thursday: Massada - Jerusalem

After breakfast, drive to **Massada**, and visit the site of the most dramatic act in Jewish History. Ascend by cable car. Explore the ancient excavations of Herod's palaces, the bathhouse, the storerooms, the ramp, and the oldest synagogue. Drive to **Jerusalem**. Enter the city of Jerusalem in the traditional way and view the city from **Mt. Scopus**. Visit the **Time Elevator**, the **City of David**, **Jeremiah's Cistern**, **Hezekiah's Tunnel** and the **Pool of Siloam**. In the afternoon visit the **Jewish Quarter** and the **Cardo**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 10 – January 18 – Friday: Jerusalem

In the morning ascend the **Mt. of Olives** and participate in sifting at **Emek Zurim**. Enter the Old City and visit the **Jewish Quarter** including the **Southern Steps** and the **Arch Park** at the **Davidson Center**. Continue to the **Last Supper Room** and **King David's Tomb**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 11 – January 19 – Saturday: Jerusalem

The day starts with a drive to the **Mt. of Olives** for a breathtaking panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem. Walk along the **Palm Sunday Way** to the **Garden of Gethsemane** where Jesus spent the last night before he was arrested and where you will have time to worship. Drive along the "last way" to Mt. Zion. Visit the **House of the High Priest Caiphas**. Then, visit the **Church of Peter in Gallicantu** (Matthew 26:31-35). This is the place where Peter denied the Lord 3 times. Enter the Old City and visit **Sisters of Zion**, **Antonia Fortress** and the **Holy Sepulchre**. End the day at the **Garden Tomb** where you will have communion. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 12 – January 20 - Sunday: Jerusalem – Departure – Tel Aviv

This morning ascend **Mt. Moriah**. Walk up to the Temple site and see the area of the Dome of the Rock and El Aqsa Mosque. Visit the Lead Arch for Caiphas and Shimon Gibson (Roman Antiquities at the Armenian Museum). Then, drive to the western side of the city and visit **Yad Vashem**, the Holocaust Museum. Return to the Old City and visit the **Rabbinical Tunnel**, the **Western Wall**, the **Western Wall Tunnel** and the **Temple Institute**. Late check out from the hotel. **Farewell dinner**. Transfer to the airport for your flight back to the USA. The London Party will be transferred to hotel in Tel Aviv for an overnight.

Day 13 – January 21 - Monday: Tel Aviv – USA/London

The flight for the USA party will depart around midnight and will arrive in the USA the same day. The London group will be transferred to the airport for their flight back to London.
